Dear Parents:

All schools in Battle River School Division, including Bawlf School, are making changes to the way we are reporting on student learning.

These changes were decided through a two-year process that included parent feedback on a BRSD survey, work by a committee of teachers and a review of draft report card templates by both teachers and school councils, who provided feedback that helped shape the final report card document.

Here's a summary of report card changes you will notice during the 2017/2018 school year:

• K to 6 report cards will include Key Learning Outcomes for each subject area.
