## Travel Study - Prior to leaving

## The Teacher-leader will:

- Inform parents/legal guardians, students and Division office of all aspects of the proposed program in writing including
  - a) Purpose or educational goal
  - b) Complete trip itinerary
  - c) Description of the activities or events proposed
  - d) Safety precautions in place to deal with activities involving risk
  - e) Emergency procedures to be followed in the event of injury, illness or unusual circumstances
  - f) Requirement for students to purchase additional medical coverage for out-of-country trips
  - g) Method of transportation to be used
  - h) Cost to the student
  - i) Expectations for student conduct while on the trip
- Ensure all participants are enrolled in appropriate CTS modules
- ensure the travel-study program is endorsed by the principal and submitted to the superintendent before the end of the preceding year
- Ensure each travel study program has a designated teacher leader in charge
- Ensure there are both male and female supervisors present and must be either staff members or members of the Board
- Ensure adult supervisors are made aware of their role and responsibilities
- Determine ahead of time what they will do if a student needs to leave the trip and an adult has to accompany them
- Carry appropriate cell phones good for international travel with the number given to their school administrator and to division office for emergency purposes
- Carry appropriate contact information so they can reach their school administrator and designated office contacts in the event of an emergency
- Carry copies of participants health insurance information, copies of each participants passport, photocopies of all airline tickets and baggage claims, parent/guardian information including home and cell #'s, email and other designated emergency contact names/numbers and copies of all must be sent to division office

## **Students must:**

- Comply with the rules of the school and the requirements of the schools student code of conduct.
- Fulfill all the preparatory requirements at an appropriate level of performance
- Participate in a responsible and cooperative manner
- Respect the rights of others
- Carry out all follow-up procedures
