Notes From Administration Mr. Dimond & Mr. Chanasyk

Happy January, Wildcats! As the temperatures drop in this last little bit, it is a reminder to us to keep active and safe. Please remember to make sure we have weather appropriate clothing for our Alberta winter. With the restrictions in place from the provincial government, we are seeing a great job being done by our students and families around keeping each other safe. Please remember to continue using the daily assessment checklist so that we can all continue to maintain our in school learning.

Report cards will be handed out for our second quarter completion on February 1st. We thank the teachers for the feedback and support in making sure all of our students are pushing for Excellence in everything that they do.

Our parent-teacher conferences will be in an online format at this time and are slated for Thursday, Februrary 4th from 3:30-6:00 p.m. for our families of ECS-Grade 8 students. Please look for a Google form to book times with the teachers in Grades 7 and 8. The elementary teachers will be

contacting families for times that will work for these interviews. As our Grade 9-12 students will be transitioning into new courses on February 1st, their interview dates will be for Wednesday, March 3rd.

For parents of students in Grades 7-12, please complete the survey around the Quarter system timetable for this current year. We would appreciate your feedback as we begin planning for the year 2021/22. We have looked at its usage this year and would like to hear the voices of our students, parents and staff around this. The closing date for that survey is February 1st.

We will be welcoming two new students to our school in the third quarter. Hyewon Yang and Muyu Tanaka, from Korea and Japan respectively, will be joining our Wildcat community after their extensive quarantine period. Please join us in showing them how wonderful our school community can be.

Senior high students have access to myPass and myBlueprint to keep track of their courses and grades and to help prepare them for life after high school. myPass is run by Alberta Education and has the official credit count and has a checklist students can look at to see how they are progressing towards graduation. Students should go into myPass after Quarter 2 to see that their courses are in there and to see their credit count. This is a great resource for future planning and all high school students should be fluent in its' usage.

We are still doing preliminary planning on our class farewell for the 2020/21 school year. We have booked the hall for April 23^{rd} for the individual graduation pictures. This is in preparation of government restrictions being lifted. If that does not happen, we will have to move to contingency plans.

Kindergarten Registrations now accepted for 2021-2022 school year ~ It is already that time! We are now accepting registration forms for ECS for the 2021-2022 school year. Kindergarten is designed for children who will be five years of age on or before December 31, 2021. Mrs. Thomsen, our Kindergarten teacher, will hopefully be having an orientation class for all pre-registered Kindergarten students, but it will be dependent on Covid protocols. This is designed to help new Kindergarten students become familiar with the school prior to the beginning of the school year. Orientation day for new ECS students will be held prior to the end of the school year. If we are unable to hold this event, pre-recorded videos of all items will be sent via email to all parents.

We are also accepting registrations for any students that will be new to Bawlf School for the 2020-2021 school year, grades one to twelve.
