

FSLW

My name is Chantal Heck and I am a Family School Liaison Worker (FSLW) at Bawlf School. The Family School Liaison Program offers free emotional support and general counseling services to students Kindergarten to Grade 12. Any student experiencing challenges at home or at school that may affect their mental health or relationships is eligible for this program. FSLW's embrace relationship building and connection as the foundational tool for change. While setting attainable goals using a strength and relationship based approach, FSLW's work with students, caregivers and school staff to provide strategies and coping skills. The Family School Liaison Program prioritizes working collaboratively with school staff and community partners to ensure that each student receives 'wrap-around' support to best meet their needs. FSLW's also offer recommendations and referrals for support services outside of a school setting, should they better fit a student's needs. Referrals can be made by parents and school staff. Students aged 13 years and younger must have parental consent to participate in the program. Students over the age of 14 years may refer themselves and provide their own consent for services.
