The start of another school year has come and gone. We are thrilled to welcome both existing and new students to Bawlf School. A special welcome to our 3 international students who have joined us this year from Japan, Spain and Belgium. The student enrollment at Bawlf School has increased slightly from last year with 305 students currently enrolled. The numbers are evenly spread across the grades with the following breakdown: K-23, Gr. 1-3=71, Gr. 4-6=73, Gr. 7-9=71, & Gr. 10-12=67.

We are also excited to have several new staff members joining the school this year. Miss Thea Young is filling in for Mr. Longhurst while he continues to be on leave. Mrs. Janessa Matthew is helping to split the Grade 5 class for part of the day. Mrs. Chantal Johnson is teaching a Grade 1/2 class while Mrs. Donohue continues to be on medical leave.
