- **Cam Lyster Memorial Dodgeball Tournament** ~ *by Mrs. Lyster* ~ Crohn's and Colitis Awareness Month in Canada is held every November. The prevalence of these Inflammatory Bowel Diseases (IBD) is increasing annually, especially in people under the age of 18 and over the age of 65. Canada has the highest incidence of IBD in the world with Alberta second in the country (after Nova Scotia) for having the highest rates of new diagnoses every year. This scary statistic makes me try to bring these invisible diseases out of the closet and into the awareness of our students and community. As usual, I presented information about these diseases to the grade 10 class to make them aware of the many symptoms of each disease for themselves and to have compassion and understanding for anyone they may know diagnosed with these illnesses. To make it memorable and add some fun to a heavy topic, every year the HSSU and I put on the Cam Lyster Memorial Dodgeball Tournament. This year, the fifth annual, took place from Tuesday, November 28 to Friday, December 9, because in a fun first, it was in a round robin format which gave everyone the opportunity to play more than once to face several competitors.

This year, the victors of a hard-fought game for the Guts and Glory Cup were the Grade 12 boys, the Purple Coilers, consisting of: Griffin, Finley, Owen, Tyler, and Ian. In second place were Grade 11 girls, The Supremes: Jaiden, Madison, Makenzie, Erik B, and Grace.
